To: THE HONOURABLE PRESIDENT JUDGE AND THE OTHER JUDGES OF THE COURT OF APPEAL OF THE DEMOCRATIC SOCIALIST REPUBLIC OF SRI LANKA

On this 19th of December 2014

Whereas the Registry informed the Petitioner that the Original Petition filed in Court in this case is 'not available in the Court Records,

And Whereas Acknowledgement Notice (No R/22 633436) of the Petition and the Affidavit was issued by the Customer Services Desk of the Registry after duly verifying the documents listed in the Motion filed in Courttogether with other connected paperwork, a copy of which is enclosed herewith marked PS

And Whereas in response to a request by the Registry a Petition signed afresh by the Petitioner was duly handed over after having entered same in the Motion Register Yesterday (18th December 2014)

And whereas the Court has now directed that the Petition cannot be supported on the requested dates(17th, 18th or 19 Dec 2014) listed in the Motion and therefore he should file a Motion with three more dates given, requesting to support the Petition, thereby effectively defeating the very objective of this Petition

And whereas the purpose of filing of this Petition would be defeated with the Court Vacation due to commence today

And whereas the matter discussed in the Petition is of grave national importance that would affect the interests of all citizens of this Country whose judicial power is being exercised by the Judiciary in trust.

And whereas, the Petitioner verily believes that disappearance of the Original Petition is a deliberate act, presumablycommitted by 'interested person/persons working in collusion with some individuals in the Court system to prevent the supporting of this

Petition in Court and thereby exposing the gross abuses of office by the 3rd Respondent who occupied the office of Chief Justice of the Supreme Court under 'Oath' knowing to the fully well that taking of the said Oath of office (undertaking to be faithful) before the Executive President at a time when there was no vacancy in the office of the Chief Justice, would tantamount to a violation of law, which reduces the oath taken by the 3rd Respondent to been a 'False Oath'amounting to an act of perjury which makes any Judicial Act performed by the 3rd Respondent ab initio void

And whereas, the citizens of this Country still entertain a glimmer of hope that the Court of Appeal, would defend and uphold the People's judicial power as required by the Constitution

Considering that the urgency and the National interest involved in this case would be defeated unless the Petitioner is permitted to support this application forthwith, the Petitioner respectfully requests that this matter may be listed for support at a special sitting of this Court either today or on Wednesday the next, the 24th December 2014 or Friday 26th Dec 2014

Petitioner further respectfully requests that as requested in the motion filed in Court on 16th December 2014 this matter may not be listed for support before a Bench comprising of Judges appointed to the Court of Appeal from the Attorney General Department for the self-explanatory reasons in the Petition.
