Dear Sirs and Madams,

As many of you will be aware, the city of Chennai in South India is currently suffering from devastating unprecedented floods and its people are in urgent need of humanitarian assistance.

Tamils Health Organization (THO) strongly believes that we, the Tamil Diaspora, have a moral obligation to help our brethren in Tamil Nadu, during their time of need. Tamil Nadu was the first place of refuge for those fleeing the civil war in Sri Lanka, and more than 100,000 Eelam Tamils continue to be sheltered in Tamil Nadu, including 60,000 in refugee camps.

In response to this catastrophe, THO has launched an emergency appeal, urging the whole Tamil community, friends and well-wishers, to unite in extending their support to the people of Chennai.

Sadly, the death toll passed 280 on Saturday 5th December, and millions of people continue to be in desperate need of shelter, food and medicine. Food stocks have been exhausted and drinking water has become scarce leaving the poor the worst affected. Also, many hospitals have had to be evacuated.

We have decided to extend our support through the Chief Minister's Public Relief Fund of the State Government of Tamil Nadu. Donations will be accepted electronically using *Virgin money giving* (http://uk.virginmoneygiving.com) from any part of the world. Gift aid will also allow the charity to receive an additional 25% of the value of your donation. No cash will be accepted directly by our volunteers.
